**Jean-Pierre DUMAS** was trader in Hamburg. In 1794, *LUBERT & DUMAS* society in Hamburg sells saltpeter, potash, rye, wheat, lambs wool for hats, iron barrels to France<sup>17</sup>. He was living in Paris, 20 rue Paradis-Poissonnière, from 1839 to 1847.

**Henry DUMAS** was trader in London (*Dumas Wylis* ?). His son, Henry John Philippe DUMAS was living Crescent Common's Clapham, n°8, in 1851.

**Emile DUMAS** went from Hamburg to Bordeaux (France) in 1820. He was selling Bordeaux wine in Germany (*Bethmann & fils* from 1820 to 1823; *de Luze & Dumas* from 1823) from 1820 to 1831. In 1839-1842, he was living in Paris, 42 rue Richer<sup>18</sup>. In 1851, he lives 89 rue d'Hauteville in Paris and is a trader for *Courvoisier & Huth*<sup>19</sup>. In 1853-1854 he trades copper for *John Schneider & Co* in London<sup>20</sup>. In 1855-1856, he lives 2 rue Barbette in Paris and sells metals for English societies.

**Charles DUMAS** was living in Paris, 89 rue d'Hauteville, in 1851.
