

STRANGE DEATH OF A YOUNG GENTLEMAN.

A few days ago Oliver J. Youlin, living in the Whittmore House, in Grove street, New-York, visited the house of Dr. Converse, on Wayne street, Jersey City Heights. About 9 o'clock on Wednesday evening he started to go home. Soon after he had gone the report of a pistol was heard in the yard. On going out, Mr. Converse discovered the dead body of young Youlin lying with a bullet-hole in the breast, at the foot of the stoop. It is not known whether the shooting was accidental or intentional. He was but sixteen years of age, and no motive for suicide is known. The body was removed to the Morgue, on Communipaw avenue, and was afterward taken to New-York City. Youlin's father is in Europe.
