

## THE GLASGOW JEWEL ROBBERY

The Glasgow police have so far made no arrest in connection with the burglary which took place in the premises of Messrs Charles Reis & Co.'s, jewellers, Jamaica Street, Glasgow. The value of the missing jewellery is now estimated at £400. It is stated that a muller was discovered in the premises of Messrs Joseph Wright, umbrella manufacturers, from which the thieves gained access to the shop, and this is regarded as a somewhat important clue.
