John Teague (son of John Teague, Governor of Giltspur Compter Prison,

London); born 14 January, bapt. at St. Olave's, Silver Street, London, 8 February 1779; succeeded his father at the Poultry Compter 26 April 1803, and was appointed to Giltspur Street Compter and Ludgate (then debtors'

prisons) 25 September 1804, and to the House of Correction in December 1815, on the removal of the debtors from Giltspur Street and Newgate to the new prison in Whitecross Street, and the removal of the House of Correction prisoners from Newgate to Giltspur Street; died at the Governor's House, Compter, Giltspur Street, West Smithfield, London, aged 62, 17 July, bur. in the East vault at St. Sepulchre's, London, 24 July 1841.
