The Last Will and Testament

of me Thomas Roberts of the Town of Cardiff in the County of Glamorgan Esquire I of Give and bequeath unto my devout Anna Page Widow all my household furniture and tools of what nature or kind soever to be delivered her by my Executor hereinafter named or in immediately after my decease. All the rest residue and remainder of my Real and Personal Estate whatsoever and whosoever situate of Give goods and bequeath unto Nicholas Priest of the said Town of Cardiff in the said County of Glamorgan Gentleman my sole Executor it is Administrators and Assigns to and for the several uses intents trusts and purposes hereinafter mentioned and declared that is to say I that the said Nicholas Priest his heirs or Executors Administrators and Assigns shall and lawfully as soon as conveniently may be after my decease sell and dispose of the whole or so much or such part of my said Estates as shall be needful and necessary to pay off and discharge all my just debts and funeral expences and the money arising by such sale to apply towards payment of my said debts funeral expences the debt now due from me to the said Nicholas Priest to be first paid and discharged and from and after payment of all my said debts and funeral expences of hereby order and direct the said Nicholas Priest his heirs Executors Administrators or Assigns to pay the Rent Issues Interest and produce of the remainder of my said Estate to my said devout Anna Page Widow yearly and every year for and during the term of her natural life and from and after her decease of Give goods and bequeath the same to the said Nicholas Priest his heirs Executors Administrators and Assigns for ever and to be every now and then constituted and appointed the said Nicholas Priest whole and sole Executor of this my said last will and Testament hereby revoking all former Wills by me or in heretofore made In witness whereof I have subscribed

my hand and seal this fourth day of April in the year of Our Lord 1783 Thomas Roberts I signed sealed published and declared by the said Testator Thomas Roberts as and for his last will and presence of us who at his request in his presence and in the presence of each other thus did as follows

This Will

was proved at London the eighth day of May in the year of Our Lord One thousand seven hundred and eighty three before the Right Worshipful Peter Vaunt Doctor of Laws Master of the High Court of Chancery or Commissary of the same Prerogative Court of Canterbury lawfully constituted by the oath of Nicholas Priest the sole Executor named in the said will to whom Administration was granted of all and singular the Goods Chattels and Credits of the deceased having been first sworn duly to administer &c
