1. I Edward Fowle of Lake House Rangoon of hereby revoke all wills codicils and other testamentary dispositions heretofore made by me and declare this to be my last will which is to take effect according to the law in force in British Burma where I am and intend to remain domiciled.

2. I appoint Emile Badelier of Rangoon my nephew and present partner in the distillery and brewery and generall business now carried on by me under the style and firm of E. Fowle & Co and Mah Kyin of Lake House Rangoon, The mother of my four natural children viz: Edward Fowle, Thomas Fowle, Rose Fowle and Robert Fowle, to be my executor and executrix and joint trustees of this my will and I declare that all trusts and powers hereinafter referred to in my trustee may be exercised by them.

3. I bequeath to Mah Kyin of Lake House & Kandawgyu Rangoon aforesaid all my watches jewels, ornaments of the person and wearing apparel and all my plates plated articles furniture, linen, & china, pictures, prints, musical instruments, books & and other articles of household use or ornament, horses carriages saddlery harness and stable furniture, live and dead stock, tools, boats, implements and utensils.

and wines, liquors household stores and provisions which respectively at the time of my death shall be in or about, or belonging to, or appropriated for the stables, coach houses, out buildings gardens and compounds thereto belonging all the above I bequeath absolutely to the said Mah Kyin.

4. I also devise to Mah Kyin aforesaid my dwelling house known as Lake House Rangoon and the stable out houses, servants' buildings and other building appurtenant thereto and ten (10) acres of ground immediately adjoining the said house for her life and after her death to Edward Fowle my eldest natural son by the said Mah Kyin, and after his death to Thomas Fowle my second natural son by the said Mah Kyin and after his death to Rose Fowle my natural daughter by the said Mah Kyin and after her death to Robert Fowle my youngest natural child by the said Mah Kyin. Provided always that my said house is intended to be reserved as a family house and home for my said natural children and their mother Mah Kyin jointly to be occupied by them, so long as they shall remain unmarried, or if married provided the consent of the devisee to whom the house shall for the time belong be obtained ground rent, Imperial and Municipal taxes to be equally paid by such of them as shall continue to occupy the said house.

In regard to all personal property, such as money in the Bank or sums due to me for principal or interest on bonds, mortgages or any other documents whatsoever, rents of houses or lands credits etc I desire and bequeath the same to Emilie Badelis and Mah Kyn my executors and executrix aforesaid or other the trustees for the time being of this my will upon trust to be applied in the manner herein after set forth. I direct Emilie Badelis and Mah Kyn my executors & executrix aforesaid or other the trustees for the time being of this my will to distribute as follows that is to say all monies received as profits on the distillery, brewery, and other business or rents from real estate or interest, or sums due to me, or monies in any Bank or Banks, to be applied in the following manner, after paying my debts and funeral and testamentary expenses viz to pay the following legacy free from legacy duty, that is to say to Charlotte Rebecca Fowle my wife from whom I have been judicially separated the sum of £ 20 twenty pounds sterling in cash, which sum I declare shall be in satisfaction and bar of all claims whatsoever in the part of the said Charlotte

Rebecca Fowle, whether under the name of dower
or feu-fief to which by the common law or by
custom she might be entitled on any account
whatsoever. The balance, I direct my executors and
trustees aforesaid to be divided into seven equal shares
and apportioned as follows viz to Mary Pyne the mother
of my four natural children one seventh, to smile
Baptister my executor and trustee aforesaid one seventh
and the same share each to my children viz: Edward
Fowle, Thomas Fowle, Rose Fowle and Robert Fowle
baptized in the Town Church of Rangoon in my name
but not born in wedlock and Emily Fowle my daughter
born in wedlock each of them to receive shares and share
alike. The yearly amount of the above incomes to be
left to the discretion of the executors and trustees
aforesaid and to be paid by them according to
the capital acquired yearly from profits in farms &
factories rents and interests, after making provision
for repairs, reserving sufficient to keep up the estate.

In the event of one or more of the legatees
of the above seven shares dying without issue his
or her share or shares to be safely divided among
the survivors. It being understood that each child

male whether legitimate or illegitimate shall be entitled
to his portion of the above legacies or shares upon attaining
the age of twenty one years ^{for} his own and absolute
use and that each female child shall be entitled to her
portion, upon marriage or upon attaining the age of
twenty one years for her own and absolute use independently
of her husband at the time being; his debts contract
and engagements

4. I further direct that my Distillery Brewery and
General business now carried on under the style and firm
of E. Fowle & Co shall continue to be carried on by my
present partner Emile Badelis my executor and trustee
aforesaid under the same style and firm's name, so long
as he can work the same to advantage and that he
shall receive as remuneration for this service the sum of £500/-
five hundred rupies per month from the profits of the
said business independently of his seventh share as one of
the seven legatees above named. And I further direct that
he the said Emile Badelis, as manager of the said firm
of E. Fowle & Co shall have full management of the said
business and be hereby empowered as manager to purchase mate-
rial for carrying on the said business and to draw and
sign cheques alone in the name of the firm for all
purposes

purposes strictly connected with the firm.

8. With respect to my real estate consisting of lands houses, farms, stock or factories (exclusive of Lake House and my house hold furniture and effects devised and bequeathed under clauses 3 & 4) I direct that all houses and lands shall remain unsold for a period of ten years or longer after my decease and I hereby bequeath all the lands, houses, factories farms, stock capital and real estate of every description (with the exceptions hereinbefore named) unto the trustees at the time of this my will, in trust for the benefit of those named in this will, according to the directions herein contained and my expressed intention which is that so soon after the expiration of ten years from my decease as my trustees shall think fit the whole property shall be divided and apportioned in seven equal shares among the legatees hereinbefore named, that is to say to Mah Ryon the mother of my four natural children and joint executrix of this my will one seventh; to Emile Badler my nephew and present partner and joint executrix to this my will one seventh; and the same share to each of my children viz Edward, Thomas, Roger

and Robert Fowle my four natural children
aforesaid, and Emily Fowle my daughter born in wedlock.
It being understood that each male child, whether
legitimate or illegitimate who shall have attained
the age of twenty one at the time of this division
of the property shall be entitled to the full use &
enjoyment of his share; and each female child upon
marriage or attaining the age of twenty one years
shall be entitled to the full and free use and enjoy-
ment of her share of the property independently
of her husband for the time being of his debts, control
and engagements. Provided always that it shall
be left to the discretion of the executors and
trustees to equally apportion such lands, houses, facto-
ries, farms, stock, real estate and capital among
the legatees aforesaid according to their discretion
and judgment should they not consider it advantageous
or desirable to sell the property - but if the property
should be sold by the trustees, then the amount realized
by such sale must be invested in Indian English or
other safe securities and must be apportioned in seven
equal shares to the seven legatees before mentioned, under
trust for those under age and for their free and sole

use if of full age.

9. And I declare that if at ~~any~~ my decease
any child hereinbefore mentioned, or any child of such
child of mine, entitled in expectancy to a share under
this my will shall be under the age of twenty one
years and being a female shall be unmarried, then
and in every such case my trustees may apply the
whole or any part of the income of the expectant
child share of such minor for or towards his or her
maintenance and education with liberty so pay the
same to the guardian of or any of the guardians of
such minor for the purpose aforesaid without
being liable to see to the application thereof Provides
always and I declare that every devise and bequest
hence or by any codicil hereunto made to any female
~~child~~ and whether in real or personal estate or of
a capital fund or sum. or other property real or personal
and whether in possession or nonpossession or
expectancy shall be for her sole and separate use
independently of any husband and of his debts,
control and engagements & her receipt alone shall
be a discharge for all monies, whether in

the nature of income or capital, accruing or payable to her during any coverture in respect of any interest or property of whatsoever description so devised or bequeathed and she shall not have power to dispose or deprive herself of the benefit by anticipation of such capital fund or sum or other property while her interest therein shall be reveresory or in expectancy

10. I further appoint Mah Ryan aforesaid <sup>Appointment
of
guardian</sup> guardian over my four natural children by her viz: Edward Fowle, Thomas Fowle, Rose Fowle and Robert Fowle and I appoint Emile Badclerk aforesaid guardian over my daughter Emily Fowle now in England. I also devise all estates vested in me as a trustee or mortgagee unto the said Emile - Badclerk and Mah Ryan subjects to the trust & equities affecting the same respectively but so that the money secured by any mortgage shall form part of my personal estates -
11. And I declare that if the trustees hereby appointed or any of them shall die in my life time or if they or any of them or any future trustees

trustee or trustees of this my will shall die or go to reside abroad or shall desire to retire from or refuse, or become incapable to act in the trusts of this my will before the same shall be fully performed, then I appoint my eldest natural son Edward Fowle to be a trustee of this my will; and in the event of his death in my lifetime, or refusing or becoming incapable to act in the trusts of this my will before the same shall be fully performed then I appoint my second natural son Thomas Fowle to be a trustee of this my will; and in the event of his death in my lifetime, or refusing or becoming incapable to act in the trusts of this my will before the same shall be fully performed, then I appoint my natural daughter Rose Fowle or in the event of her death or inability to act, then to my youngest natural son Robert Fowle to be a trustee of this my will.

12. Lastly I direct that my body shall not be buried but cremated on my ground - at Lake House and for this purpose direct that my body be given

1. This is a Codicil to the last will and testament of me Edward Fowle of Lake House Rangoon dated the twentieth day of March 1882 -
2. Whereas by clause 2 of the said will I have appointed Emile Badelier and Mah Kyin to be joint executors and executors and trustees under my will I hereby appoint Charles John Brown Secretary of the Municipality of Rangoon to act as executor and trustee to my estate in addition to the above executors and executive trustees and that in the event of any dispute between the executors then the decision of the majority shall stand good -
3. Whereas also under clause (8) of my said will bearing the above date it is declared that all real estate consisting of lands, houses, farms, stock or factories (exclusive of Lake House, and household furniture and personal effects devised and bequeathed under clauses 3 and 4) shall remain unsold for a period of ten years or longer after my decease. Now I hereby revoke this portion of the said clause and declare that I desire all my property not devised under clauses 3 & 4 shall be sold at any time after my death as the executors to my will may ^{desire} proper provided that a longer period than one

year shall not expire after my death before the
sale of the said property.

4. I also make & cause so much of the same clause
(8) which stipulates that the proceeds realized by the
sale of all property shall be invested in Indian,
English, or other safe securities before being apportioned
to my seven heirs mentioned in the will. Now I
declare it to be my wish that after the sale of
my property or the sale of any portion thereof I desire
that all those who are to receive any portion of the
proceeds thereof as mentioned and contained in my said
will and who are over 21 years of age shall be paid
their portions thereof without unnecessary delay
and shall have full and absolute control over their
portion or share and that the portion or portions
of those who have not attained their twenty first
year of age is or are to be placed in trust in Govt.
or other good securities for the said persons till
such time as they shall attain the age of 21
years.

5. In all other respects I confirm my said will
6. In witness whereof the said Edward Fowle have
to this codicil set my hand this twenty first

day of October in the year of our Lord one
thousand eight hundred eighty four - 22
